Communication

- Text Messages  – Send a message without calling.
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- Video Calls  – Talk face-to-face from anywhere!
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- Notifications  – Alerts that pop up on your screen.

Internet & Safety

- Wifi  – Connects your device to the internet.
- Scams  – If it sounds too good to be true, it probably is!
- Strong Passwords  – Use letters, numbers & symbols.

Everyday Tech Use

- GPS  – Helps you find locations.
